The Rowans Primary Outreach Service is a provision which enables young people to change the direction of their lives. Through a trauma informed approach, positive relationships and a strong focus on our core values of kindness, commitment and resilience, all pupils have the opportunity to re-engage with education, taking ownership of their lives and their choices.

Our 'Developing Engagement through Nature' project is a bespoke intervention offered by our Primary Outreach Team, aiming to provide pupils with the chance to work at building the skills needed to develop resilience, confidence, improve social skills, positively boost mental health, cope with change, re-engage with education and develop a sense of belonging.
